THAMBAL MARIK COLLEGE SEIHOU ESIE (COLLEGE ANTHEM) AND ITS AUTHOR

The Thambal Marik College, Oinam was established on the 28th September, 1980 as a private college by Yumnam Yaima Singh, the then Speaker, Manipur Legislative Assembly and later on the college was inaugurated by S.M.H. Burney on the 14th November, 1981. Afterwards, the Governing Body of the College had invited the employees of the college to submit their scripts of community song. Three employees of the College had submitted their scripts of community song to the authority.

The screening committee of the Governing Body, Thambal Marik College, Oinam (Private) discussed minutely about the scripts of the community songs composed by three employees of the college and the script of community song composed by O. Ibomcha Singh, an AIR Imphal approved lyricist and Founder Head Clerk, Thambal Marik College, Oinam (Private) was finally selected.

Oinam Ibomcha Singh alias ICS, Oinam was born on the 1st March, 1951 at Oinam, Bishnupur District, Manipur. He is the son of Shri Oinam Hajoor Singh and Smt. Oinam Ongbi Minakunari Devi. He belongs to middle class family both from the paternal and maternal side. O. Ibomcha Singh had his earliest schooling at Oinam Boys High School. He passed the Matriculation Examination in 1967 under Board of Secondary Education, Assam. He passed his Pre-University Arts Examination in 1969 from Imphal College, affiliated to Guwahati University. Then he graduated from Imphal College, affiliated to Guwahati University in 1972. He was the Founder Head Clerk of Thambal Marik College (Private). He distinguishes himself in every branch of the work of his class-sports, handicraft works and classical tabla, khol, naal and dholaki etc.

The Governing Body, Thambal Marik College, Oinam (Private) had taken a resolution on the adoption of an EMBLEM of the College of its own. Accordingly, a notification to this effect, inviting tenders from the members/staff and other intellectuals was issued to submit their model /sample, to the Principal of the College for discussion in the Governing Body Meetings.

In response to the notification, the model for emblem design by Oinam Ibomcha Singh was approved.

Significance of the EMBLEM

1. Blooming Lotus: It signifies the young buds/young learners/students
2. Water Level Markings: It signifies the never-ending process of learning, in short, the ocean of Knowledge / Learning.
3. Evergreen leaves: It signifies full of energy never fading away.
4. Knot: The interpretation is "United we stand divided we fall".
5. Date of Establishment: The 28th September, 1980.

This is the Motto of Thambal Marik College - Unity is strength. It means staying united in all situations. It has a great value in all walks of life. When we are united then we can surmount any challenges and accomplish any goal.

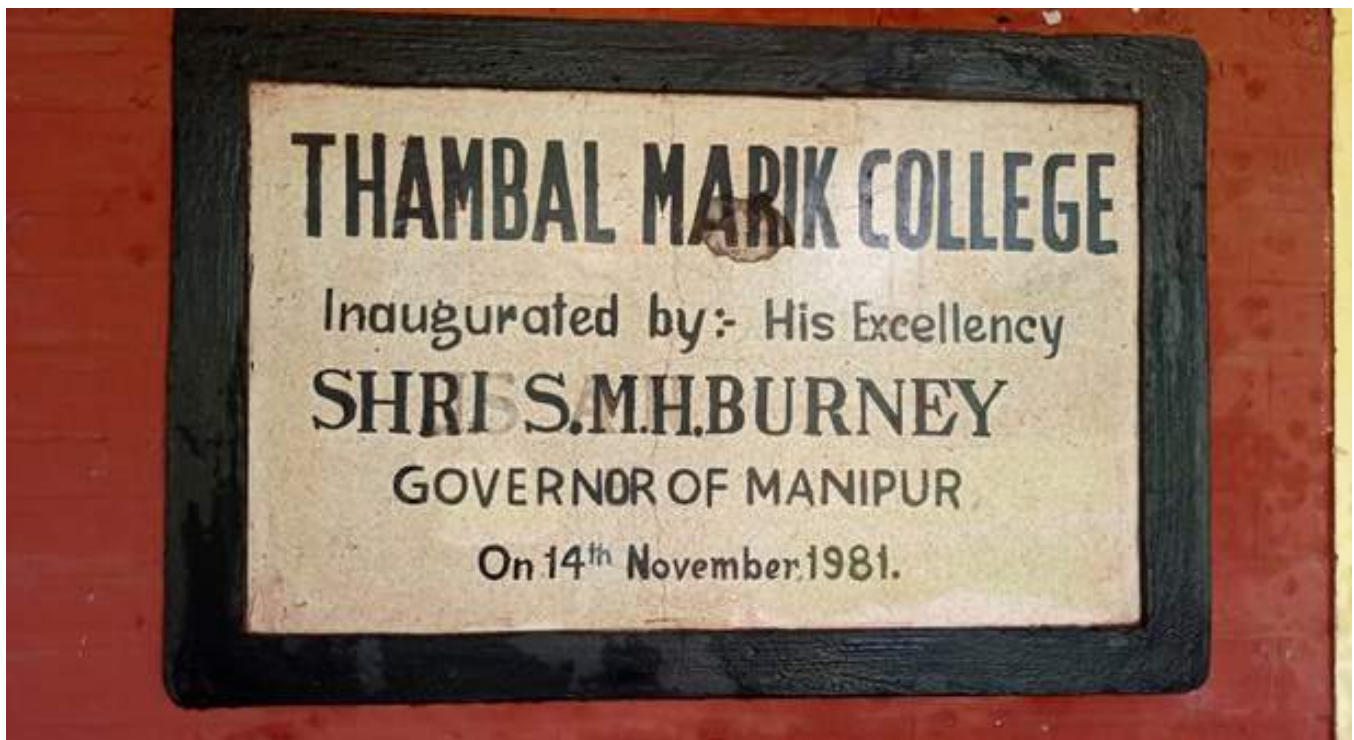

MY ALMA MATER, THE THAMBAL MARIK COLLEGE

It is a matter of pride, to be the student of this very special and great college -Thambal Marik college, Oinam. This does not, at all, mean that alumni of other colleges are in any manner not as fortunate or privileged as those of the Thambal Marik College. I, in this article, will try to point out what is so special about this great college, that its old students all over the country feel proud to be its product. I am fortunate in the sense that I am working as Asst. Professor of Physical Education, Thambal Marik College.

The Thambal Marik College, Oinam was founded by the great personality of Oinam, Mr. (L) Yumnam Yaima Singh (Speaker, Manipur Legislative Assembly) with his team in the year 1980. He was not only a great leader of Oinam but also the most admired man in the State. He is the godfather of Thambal Marik College. This wouldn't have been possible to open a college- Thambal Marik College at Oinam without their effort. Conversion of the Thambal Marik College (Aided College) to full-fledged Government College, was the dream of employees of the College. In the year 1981, the authority of the College entitled as Governing Body was the sole authority of the Private College, Grant-in- Aid and Aided College. The Governing Body gives direction to the college management. The Governing Body shall consist of two members elected by the Guardian Election, two local Educationist, one or two members from Teacher's representatives, two members from Manipur University and Principal of the College(ex-officio). Any development of the College was planned by the Governing Body. Employees of the college were appointed by the Governing Body with proper channel. At the time of appointment, everyone was very happy with a new hope. After a few years, employees started worrying about their life and felt insecure. In the sense they could not manage their family with the salaries given by the college Authority. There was group discussion among the employees. They politely requested the authority to increase the salaries by saying that they could not manage their families with the salary. But no positive response from the authorities. Some of the authorities were very helpful. Some of the authorities were worried about the employees' salaries. Thousands of questions arose in the mind of employees of the college. Who can solve the problems? Who will solve the problems? Thus, the college was going through agony for a long time. The college authority did their work without any hesitation. The employees were confused and hopeless. The female employees were underestimated by their husbands and their kids. Male employees of the college were also facing with the same problems. These were the problems faced by the employees of the college during Aided period. The employees were searching for alternative way of earning to maintain their family. When All Manipur Government Aided College Teacher Association (AMGACTA) came into existence, it started demanding for full-fledged Government college. This pressure group approached to the Manipur Government for solving the problems. Many a time MoU have been signed between the Association (AMGACTA) and representative of Manipur Government. But no positive responses were received. Here, I would like to mention some important agreements signed between the Hon'ble Education Minister with their staff of the Higher and Technical Education, Govt. of Manipur on the 1st Oct. 1994 at 2 p.m. in the office chamber of the Education Minister (Higher and Technical Education, Govt of Manipur).The Education Department prepared the Cabinet Memorandum for conversion of the 6 Aided Colleges into full- fledged Govt. Colleges w.e.f. the month of July 2000 as decided in the Cabinet

Meeting held on the 30th August, 1999. From the Association side, the following three persons had signed the agreement. 1. R.K. Sadananda Singh President of the Association. 2. H. Nabakanta Singh, Vice President of the Association. 3. L. Bijoy. Singh Secretary of the Association. Our association took a serious approach to the Government for the conversion of 6 (six) Aided College. In those days our Association and Manipur government signed the agreements on the 25th May, 1993. The employees were struggling for existence. Afterwards new Executive Body members of the Employees Association, Thambal Marik College was unanimously elected on the 21st July 2017. The following office bearers were elected as new office bearer of the Association. 1. Dr. M. Shomorendra Singh - Chairman, 2. L. Baleshwor Singh - General Secretary 3. L. Jamuna Devi - Vice Chairman 4. N. Shushila Devi — Vice Chairman. Then BJP Government came into force. By taking reference of the previous committees of the AMGACTA, a new Executive Committee was formed in the year 2017. Seven members from new six colleges formed the Executive Committee. The six colleges are: 1. Thambal Marik College, Oinam 2. Liberal College, Luwangsangbam 3. Kakching Khunou College, Kakching Khunou 4. Mayai Lambi College, Yumnam Huidrom 5. Standard College, Kongba 6. Biramangol College, Swombung. These 42 members elected Shri Longjam Baleshwor Singh, Asst. Professor, Thambal Marik College, Oinam as President of the AMGACTA and Shri Th. Inaobi Singh, Asst. Professor of Liberal College as Secretary of the Association. Among these 42 members, Shri Dr. R.K. Romen, Th. Bimol Singh from Thambal Marik College, Shri Dr. L. Ibohanbi Singh, Kakching Khunou College, Mr. Shyam Singh and Dr. Jaychandra Singh, Mayai Lambi College, Pradeep Singh Liberal College were executive members under the leadership of President and Secretary of the Association. The Association worked hard to convert the six aided colleges to full-fledged Government colleges. Before the meeting with the concerned authority, our team collected all the relevant documents. Then our team had taken advice from the prominent personality- BB Shanna. He advised us to make the power point for the presentation before the EM, CM, Director, Finance Minister, Commissioner of the Government. Finally, our team succeeded in our mission for conversion from Aided College to full-fledged Government College. We turned to a new life. Now we are enjoying with our family. I specially give thanks to the employees of our Thambal Marik College because they encourage me to fight for our goal. Last but not the least, I would like to extend my sincere thanks to all the employees of the College. I also extend my gratitude to the Governing Body because they appointed us to serve in the college.

Thus, I have been a part of Thambal Marik College forever and have so many memories with me that I can go on and on with them. But that is not possible in a write up for an Alumni Directory to be published on the great occasion of the 1st Thambal Marik College Alumni Meet. I have, therefore, tried to show why and how this college, to which I owe everything in my life, is really different and unique from other colleges in Manipur.

THAMBAL MARIK COLLEGE, OINAM BISHNUPUR DISTRICT, MANIPUR NAAC ACCREDITED 'B' GRADE COLLEGE (2ND CYCLE)

The Thambal Marik College is a NAAC accredited 'B' Grade Government College located at Oinam, Bishnupur district, Manipur. It was established on the 28th September, 1980 as a private college with financial assistance from late Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh (donor) in memory of his loving mother late Smt. Laishram ongbi Thambalmarik Devi of Sega Road, Imphal with the dedicated people, sympathizers and local educationists of Oinam, Heinoubok, Maibam, Yumnam Khunou, Keinou, Irengbam headed by Shri Yumnam Yaima Singh, Ex MP, Lok Sabha. The college was converted to a full-fledged Government college on the 28th September 2018. The college imparts education in both Science and Arts streams. It was granted temporary affiliation in the year 1983 by the Manipur University. Further the college obtained the status of permanent affiliation in the year 1997 and was included under section 2(f) and 12 (b) of UGC Act 1956. Since its inception, the college have opened 10+2 courses as well as BA and BSc courses. Now, the College offers Honours Courses in the 16 subjects and one having Vocational Course in Tourism and Hospitality management under RUSA.

Smt. Laishram ongbi Thambalmarik Devi was born on the 10th of Thawan, Tuesday, 1907 at Ngaikhong Khullen of Bishnupur District. She was the daughter of Takhellambam Chaoba and Smt. Thagoi Devi. At the age of eighteen, she got married with Laishram Yaima Singh. She left a daughter and a son, Rashmi Devi and Ibobi Singh. Her husband left for heavenly abode at the age of 46. Widowed at a young age, she faced many hardships in life. Being born in a poor family, she could not get proper education. She dedicated herself to spiritual and educational commitment. Sacrifice and charity for downtrodden people was her cherished goal. In 1937, she donated one temple at her hometown at Ngaikhong Khullen but not satisfied with it. In 1941, she donated land for temple at Bishnupur Awang Leikai. In 1977, once again she constructed one temple and one Mandhop in Ngaikhong Khullen. In 1979, she donated some portion of the building at Children Ideal High School. In 1987, she donated one Mandir in Bishnupur District. On Friday, 1st July, 1988 (17th of Inga), she died in the wee hours of morning at the residence of Konjeng Hazari Leikai at the age of 82.

Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh, the second child of Smt. Thambalmarik, was born on the 5th September, 1927 at Ngaikhong Khullen in Bishnupur District. Being a child born in a poor family, he could complete formal education upto 5th Standard (Manga shuba) only. To support the families, he went to city to seek a job. As good luck would have it and with hard work and determination, he was successful in his business. He was known as "Agar Ibobi" after his successful business dealing with sandal wood. He became a special class contractor of the Government of Manipur from 1975 onwards.

During his business era he won many awards given by the State Government for his excellent work. Among his awards, the Merit Certificate of PWD, IFCD in the year 1988 and the Merit Award on the Republic Day of 1983 given by Shri S.M.H. Burney, His Excellency, the Governor of Manipur.

Sri Yumnam Yaima Singh and his Colleagues from Oinam, Yumnam Khunou, Keinou, Maibam, Irengbam, Leimaram and Ngaikhong Khunou Villages have together decided to have a college. It was a dream of the Local Villagers. The members have purposed different names of the College.

For the first time Shri Ngangom Naba Singh, Head Master, Oinam High School was appointed as Principal of the College.

Different meetings were held at two places.

1. On 27/09/1980 : It was held at the residence of Oinam Angou Singh
2. On 12/10/1980: Meeting at Oinam Boy's High School.

The committee faced a lot of financial problem to start the building construction. So the Committee requested Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh of Sega Road Konjeng Hajari Leikai for financial assistance for the construction of the college. Shri L. Ibobi Singh accepted their request and he generously donated Rs 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) in the name of his Mother Smt. Laishram (o) Thambalmarik Devi. Later he also donated bricks and Rupees three lakhs.
