ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The Thambal Marik College is a NAAC, Bangalore accredited 'B' Grade Government co-educational College located at Oinam, Bishnupur District, Manipur. It was established on the 28th September, 1980 as a private college with financial support from late Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh (donor) in memory of his loving mother late Smt. Laishram (O) Thambalmarik Devi of Sega road, Imphal with the dedicated peoples, sympathizers and local educationists of Oinam, Heinoubok, Maibam, Oinam Khunou, Keinou, Irengbam headed by late Shri Y. Yaima Singh, hon'ble ex M.P., Lok Shabha. It was converted into a full-fledged Government college on 22nd Feb. 2019. The college is providing education in both Science and Arts streams. It was granted temporary affiliation in the year 1983 by the Manipur University. Further, the college obtained the status of permanent affiliation from Manipur University in the year 1997 and included under section 2(f) & 12(b) of UGC act 1956. From its inception, the college opened 10+2 courses as well as B.A. and B.Sc. courses. Now, the college offers honours and general courses in 15 subjects and one having vocational course in Tourism and Hospitality management under RUSA, Government of Manipur.

Department of Zoology, Physics, History and Mathematics are providing research facilities under Manipur University, Canchipur and other Universities. Moreover, some UGC, DBT and DST granted research projects are also undergone in Zoology, Physics, Chemistry, Statistics, Home Science, Botany, Mathematics and Anthropology departments of the college.

How to Apply?

i) Registration form can be downloaded from www.registrationuhe.in and Prospectus along with admission form can be available from the college website www.thambalmarikcollege.ac.in.

ii) The duly filled in registration form along with relevant documents should be submitted online only to www.registrationuhe.in on or before the stipulated time.

iii) Students willing to apply for Science and Arts stream should take separate registration forms.

A sum of Rs. 250 will be charged by the college from the registered candidates only as Admission processing fee.

Documents to be furnished along with the admission form at the time of submission.

a) Three recent colour passport-size photographs.
b) Three self-attested photocopy of mark sheet and certificate of High School Leaving Certificate Examination or its equivalent.

c) Three self-attested photocopy of mark sheet and certificate of Higher Secondary Examination or its equivalent. d) One self-attested photocopy of valid Schedule Caste/ScheduleTribe/OBC/OBC(MP)/Orphan certificate issued by the competent authority.

e) One self-attested photocopy of Court Affidavit for the Differently Able Persons (DAP).

 f) One self-attested photocopy of Sports certificate
 (s) [National and / or International level] issued by the competent authority for candidates applied in Sports category.

g) One self-attested photocopy of supporting document of Ex-servicemen parent for candidates applied in Ex -servicemen category.

h) One self-attested photocopy of AADHAAR card.

Eligibility

Candidates who passed 10+2 or equivalent examination securing 45% marks from a recognized Board/ Council can apply in the prescribed form for admission to B.A. & B.Sc. 1st Semester 2021. However, 5% marks relaxation for ST/SC/OBC/PWD/Sports Person of Eminence/ Children of Ex-Servicemen shall be in force. Application form in the prescribed form only will be considered.

Reservation:

Reservation policy as notified by the state government from time to time shall be followed.

Mode of Selection

a) Selection will be made on the basis of merit and subject to the verification of original documents at the time of counselling.

b) Counselling shall be done after the common merit list is published. Students who fail to take part in the counselling at the given date and time shall not be allowed to get admission even though he/she is listed in the common merit list.



Mode of payment for admission fees:

Admission fees as fixed by the Government are to be paid at the Bank through Bank Challans issued by the College authority during the stipulated time for admission.

N.B.: The decision of the Admission Committee of Thambal Marik College will be final on any matter related to admission.
