

## A BRIEF HISTORY OF THAMBAL MARIK COLLEGE:

The Thambal Marik College is a NAAC accredited 'B' Grade Government College located at Oinam, Bishnupur district, Manipur. It was established on the 28<sup>th</sup> September, 1980 as a private college with financial assistance from late Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh (donor) in memory of his loving mother late Smt. Laishram ongbi Thambalmarik Devi of Sega Road, Imphal with the dedicated people, sympathizers and local educationists of Oinam, Heinoubok, Maibam, Yumnam Khunou, Keinou, Irengbam headed by Shri Yumnam Yaima Singh, Ex MP, Lok Sabha. The college was converted to a full -fledged Government college on the 28<sup>th</sup> September 2018. The college imparts education in both Science and Arts streams. It was granted temporary affiliation in the year 1983 by the Manipur University. Further the college obtained the status of permanent affiliation in the year 1997 and was included under section 2(f) and 12 (b) of UGC Act 1956. Since its inception, the college have opened 10+2 courses as well as BA and BSc courses. Now, the College offers Honours Courses in 16 subjects and one having Vocational Course in Tourism and Hospitality management under RUSA.

Smt. Laishram ongbi Thambalmarik Devi was born on the 10<sup>th</sup> of Thawan, Tuesday, 1907 at Ngaikhong Khullen of Bishnupur District. She was the daughter of Takhellambam Chaoba and Smt. Thagoi Devi. At the age of eighteen, she got married with Laishram Yaima Singh. She left a daughter and a son, Rashmi Devi and Ibobi Singh. Her husband left for heavenly abode at the age of 46. Widowed at a young age, she faced many hardships in life. Being born in a poor family, she could not get proper education. She dedicated herself to spiritual and educational commitment. Sacrifice and charity for downtrodden people was her cherished goal. In 1937, she donated one temple at her hometown at Ngaikhong Khullen but not satisfied with it. In 1941, she donated land for temple at Bishnupur Awang Leikai. In 1977, once again she constructed one temple and one Mandhop in Ngaikhong Khullen. In 1979, she donated some portion of the building at Children Ideal High School. In 1987, she donated one Mandir in Bishnupur District. On Friday, 1st July, 1988 (17th of Inga), she died in the wee hours of morning at the residence of Konjeng Hazari Leikai at the age of 82.

Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh, the second child of Smt. Thambalmarik, was born on the 5<sup>th</sup> September, 1927 at Ngaikhong Khullen in Bishnupur District. Being a child born in a poor family, he could complete formal education upto 5<sup>th</sup> Standard (Manga shuba) only. To support the families, he went to city to seek a job. As good luck would have it and with hard work and determination, he was successful in his business. He was known as "Agor Ibobi" after his successful business dealing with sandal wood. He became a special class contractor of the Government of Manipur from 1975 onwards.

During his business era he won many awards given by the State Government for his excellent work. Among his awards, the Merit Certificate of PWD, IFCD in the year 1988 and the Merit Award on the Republic Day of 1983 given by Shri S.M.H. Burney, His Excellency, Governor of Manipur.

Sri Yumnam Yaima Singh and his Colleagues from Oinam, Yumnam Khunou, Keinou, Maibam, Irengbam, Leimaram and Ngaikhong Khunou Villages have together decided to have a college at Oinam. It was a dream of the Local Villagers. The members have purposed different names of the College.

#### They are:

- 2. Loyalam College and
- 3. Martyr's Memorial College.

At the end of the meeting, they have decided as Netaji Memorial College. The members of the first Governing Body of the College were:

#### Different meetings were held.

- 1. First meeting was held at Oinam Public Hall, near Ushak Khangdabi, Oinam.
- 2. On 27/09/1980: It was held at the residence of Oinam Angou Singh
- 3. On 12/10/1980: Meeting at Oinam Boy's High School.

The committee faced a lot of financial problem to start the building construction. So the Committee requested Shri Laishram Ibobi Singh of Sega Road Konjeng Hajari Leikai for financial assistance for the construction of the college. Shri L. Ibobi Singh accepted their request and he generously donated Rs 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) in the name of his Mother Smt. Laishram (o) Thambalmarik Devi. Later he also donated bricks and Rs. 3,00,000 /- (Rupees three lakhs).

For the first time Shri Ngangom Naba Singh, Head Master, Oinam High School was appointed as Principal of Thambal Marik College but due to his service he couldn't accept the offer. Afterwards, Shri Mutum Amutombi Singh was appointed as the first principal of the college as per records available.

Then Netaji Memorial College has been changed to Thambal Marik College, Oinam. The college foundation stone was laid on the 28<sup>th</sup> September, 1980 and inaugurated on the 14<sup>th</sup> November, 1981. # BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF SHRI YUMNAM YAIMA SINGH,

#### FOUNDER, THAMBAL MARIK COLLEGE, OINAM



(28 August 1922 – 3 March 2017)

Shri Yumnam Yaima Singh was a genius whose life was devoted to the service of the people. He was born on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 1922 and died on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2017, at the age of 94. With deep reverence we pay deepest homage to Shri Yumnam Yaima Singh. Shri Yumnam Yaima Singh. was a visionary statesmen and beloved leader of Manipur. He was an Indian politician from Manipur. He was elected many times as Member of Legislative Assembly from 25-Oinam Constituency. He was elected Member of Parliament in the 10<sup>th</sup> Lok Sabha from the Inner Manipur Parliamentary Constituency in 1991.

He always thought for the welfare of the society. He had a dream to have a College in his Locality. His life was an embodiment of dedication, service, and sacrifice for the people of Manipur and the nation. As the Founder of Thambal Marik College, Oinam, Shri Yaima Singh also laid the foundation of higher education in our region, opening doors of knowledge and opportunities for countless young minds. His vision for education was rooted in the belief that true progress of a society can only be achieved through learning and enlightenment.

Thambal Marik College, Oinam was established on 28<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1980 by Y. Yaima Singh, when he was Speaker of Manipur Legislative Assembly. Shri Yaima Singh will forever be remembered as a guiding force who inspired us with his humility, wisdom, and unwavering devotion to the betterment of society. His legacy will continue to live on through the generations of students, leaders, and citizens who draw inspiration from his life and work.
